### Lists - Snap

#### A list keeps track of multiple values – Compared to a variable which keeps track of one value



## List Access

 Click the arrow of the list to add an item to the list



• Assign the list to a variable



• Access items in the list



- Works like a function in math
- $f(x) = \sqrt{x} \qquad 0 \le x$

#### This function takes the first letter of each item in


the list




Input: a list

Each item in the list gets placed in the blank, the calculation of whatever function we're using gets evaluated, and the result is output to a list.
